The Central Texas Law Enforcement Executives Association (CTLEEA) is pleased to announce the availability of scholarships for the 2025 Fall Semester. The children of active peace officers and telecommunications officers of CTLEEA agencies and those active peace officers and telecommunications officers who work for CTLEEA agencies are eligible to apply for a scholarship. Starting last year, vocational studies are also considered for scholarships.

We ask that you review each application and <u>provide a written recommendation</u> based on your knowledge of the applicant's merit and educational motivation.

The Scholarship Committee will give preference to applications in the order listed below. In addition, as proceeds directed to scholarships can fluctuate year to year, the Committee may make recommendations for full or partial awards. There may be occasions where, due to the number of applicants, not all qualifying applicants can be awarded a scholarship.

- 1. Graduating seniors making first application
- 2. Active peace officers and communications officers
- 3. Returning or continuing students
- 4. Graduate students

Because proceeds directed to scholarships fluctuate year to year, ranking preference will be given to graduating high school seniors. The Scholarship Committee may also recommend full or partial awards based on funding.
